



2019 Application Form

The Victor Tolgesy Arts Award was inaugurated in 1987 by the City of Ottawa and the Ottawa Arts Council to recognise the accomplishments of residents who have contributed substantially to enriching cultural life in the city. It is named in honour of the Ottawa artist Victor Tolgesy who died in 1980.

This award is presented as a joint venture of the City of Ottawa and Ottawa Arts Council to recognize an individual who has significantly contributed to the Ottawa arts community. The award recipient receives a bronze cast of the late Victor Tolgesy's 1963 sculpture titled "Seed and Flower" provided by the City of Ottawa as well as a cash prize of \$5,000.

An individual may be nominated by filling out this form and gathering the required supporting documents, including a letter of nomination. The completed package should be submitted to awards@ottawaartscouncil.ca via [WeTransfer.com](https://www.wetransfer.com) or email before the deadline.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants for this award must:

- Be nominated by an individual or group who may not nominate more than one individual per year.
- Have lived in the National Capital Region (defined as 75 km from Parliament Hill) for the previous five years.
- Not have previously received this award.

Evaluation Criteria

- The diversity of the nominee's accomplishments.
- The impact of the nominee's contribution to the arts in Ottawa.
- The extent of their role in the development of the Ottawa arts community.
